New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to realworld situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2022, 294 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas.

For Lyncourt first-grader James Woods, the Stellata program at the OCM BOCES Crown Road Campus has provided him with the structure and support he needs to learn and grow.

James, who has autism, has made steady progress in communicating his wants and needs with the help of his teachers and classroom visuals. He benefits from the flexibility of the program, which allows him to take "sensory breaks" in an adjacent sensory room. There, he loves to jump, crawl through tunnels, and be active in a safe, welcoming space.

Most of all, James gets a chance to shine because his creativity helps him learn, said his teacher, Traci Brewster. Because he loves using Play-Doh, for example, Brewster uses the molding compound to help him count and recognize numbers. When he completes teacher-directed math

tasks - James has gotten up to three tasks in a row - he gets to play with classroom toys, go to the sensory room, or build figurines out of the Play-Doh. James is so good at shaping Play-Doh, he can create figurines such as Simba from "The Lion King" and Bob the Tomato from "Veggie Tales."

"He is so creative, and he just has a great personality," Brewster said. "I think he is really doing well with the structure and routine of the classroom."

Brewster is confident the Stellata program will continue to be a good fit for James, who first came to OCM BOCES last

"He's doing really well and showing steady growth," she said. "I really enjoy having him in class."
