

Race To The Top

- Standards
 - Districts shared some of their experiences with the modules. The overall comments were that the modules weren't bad and, in some cases, stduents are clearly doing more than they did in the past. Pacing issues were, however, voiced repestedly.
 - JD has a webpage with resources to help parents with the math modules
 - Continue to update the <u>chart</u> that displays each district's plans for the modules and CC-aligned Regents exams
 - All of the math modules K-9 are up. The first geometry is up.
