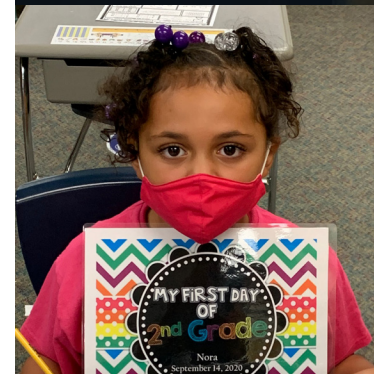

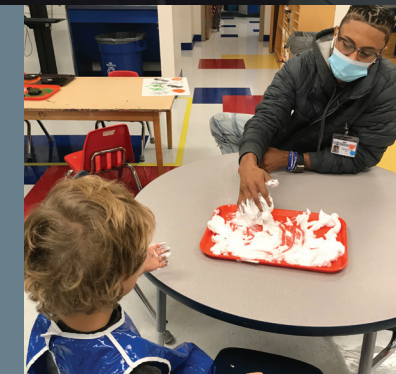

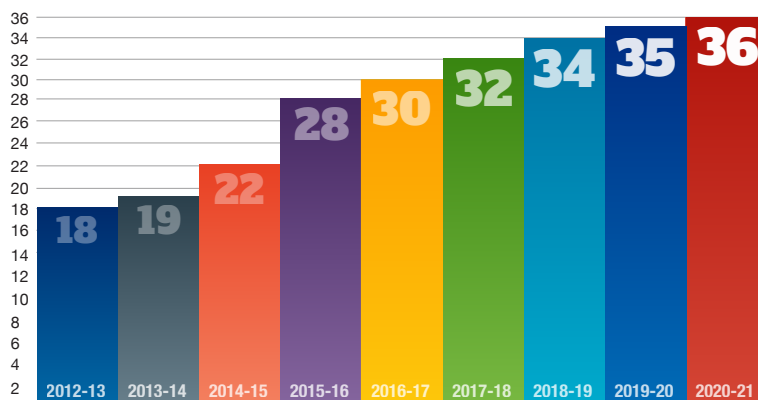
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2020, 441 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Lyncourt student Jacob Monty.

Nora Joyce, a second-grader from the Lyncourt Union Free School District, has become much more confident, independent and sociable as she enters her third year in the OCM BOCES SED Program at Long Branch Elementary School in Liverpool. Teachers and family members attribute her success to the program's smaller class size, which allows her to get the individualized attention she needs.

"Nora has grown in many ways socially, emotionally, academically, and behaviorally," said her teacher, Lauren Grimmitt. "She has also made gains academically, particularly with her math-fact fluency skills and her high-frequency word knowledge. Nora is a very social individual who is learning to interact in a more pro-social manner."

Nora's father, Weslie Joyce, has seen a remarkable improvement.

"BOCES has helped Nora gain the self-confidence she needs to be a great student and friend," he said. "She has been able to make so many new friends and learn lots of new things."

Nora loves animals — especially dogs — and hopes to one day work at Helping Hounds Dog Rescue. She thinks BOCES has helped her learn and grow, especially because she feels more comfortable with math and reading. In addition to her academic confidence, Nora says, "BOCES has helped me learn to get along better with my friends and teachers."

Grimmett and a school social worker, Siobhan Bussone, love working with Nora. They say she has a big smile, a positive attitude, and a wonderful desire to share her knowledge and participate in class.

"Nora has such a good heart!" Grimmitt said. "Nora's love for learning is contagious, and she loves to make others laugh."
