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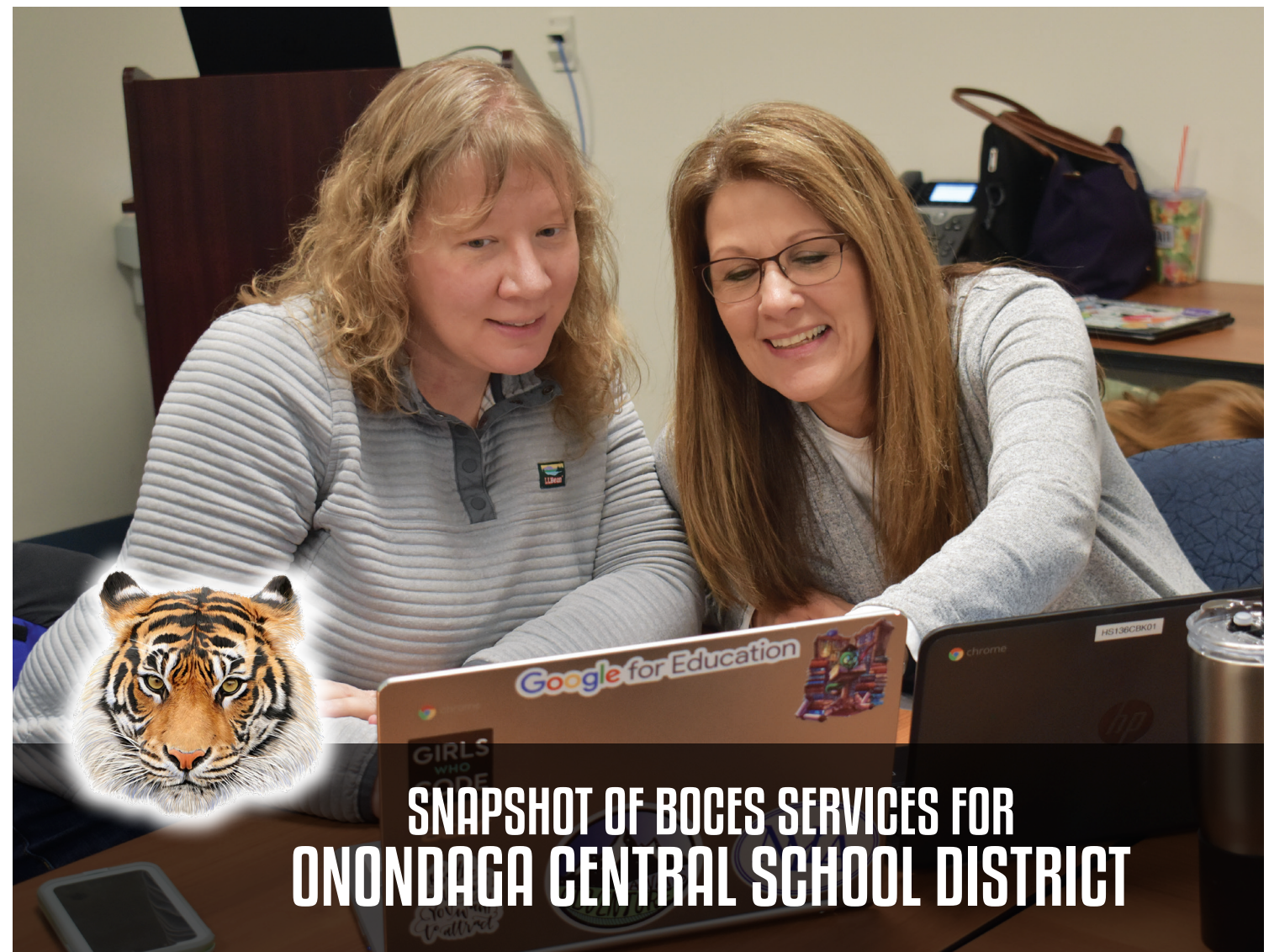
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# SNAPSHOT OF BOCES SERVICES FOR ONONDAGA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

**\$33,302**

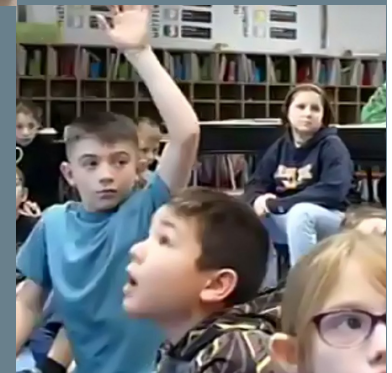


Through cooperative purchasing, in 2019-20 Onondaga saved an estimated

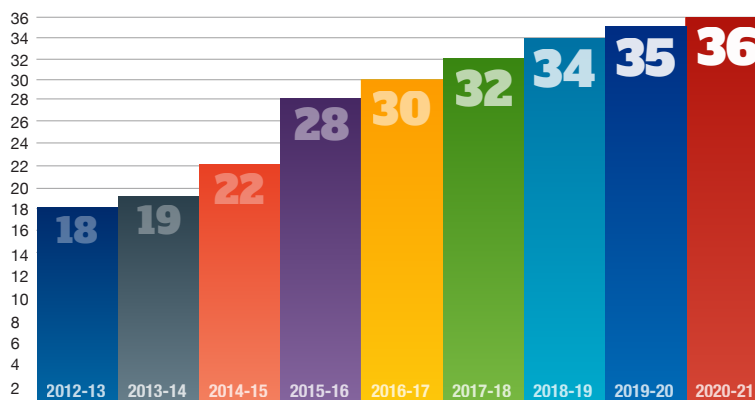
## Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2020, 441 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Onondaga students Sean Fitzpatrick-Dwyer, Devon Robinson, Brandon Rodriguez, and Ty Zych.

## OCM BOCES & Onondaga = Student Success



William Naylor has benefited from a satisfying mix of work experience and classroom instruction during his time this year in the OCM BOCES Transition Program at Onondaga Community College (OCC). William has learned important work skills doing food preparation in the dining hall at OCC. Another job takes him to the OCM BOCES Science Center, where he assembles hands-on instructional science kits for teachers to use in their classrooms. He also uses his food-preparation skills in the community, helping volunteers at the downtown Samaritan Center prepare thousands of meals for those in need.

His teacher, Luke Tatusko, says William "has grown both as a student and as a person" in his time with the Transition Program.

"William has thrived in the community setting, has learned important job skills, and is able to demonstrate his independence in a variety of environments," Tatusko said. "This program has given William access to a bigger world, and has helped him find his place in it."

William says his favorite aspects of BOCES include community outings, speech, and his job in the science center. Looking ahead, he would love to "work and earn money," especially in a group setting. One of his teachers, Kristen Bartoszewski, says Williams would be a great employee because he has a positive influence on everybody around him, especially in the classroom.

"William adds character and charm to our classroom with his witty sense of humor," she said.

## Did You Know?

The Onondaga Central School District has joined the Teacher Immersion Program for the 2020-2021 school year. Currently, four SUNY Cortland education majors are working as substitute teachers on a weekly basis across the district. These students were screened and interviewed by both OCM BOCES and Onondaga, and, in addition to being a regular presence in the classroom, will participate in professional development sessions tailored to the unique role of substitute teaching. This program helps aspiring educators gain incredible experience, while also helping districts like Onondaga fill substitute teaching positions.
