

- M District enrollment: 1,407 students

Marcellus High School consistently receives excellent SAT scores with critical reading averages of 600 or more and math averages of over 600, with more than half the senior class taking the exam.
- M Graduating classes have approximately a 91% rate of achieving Regents diplomas or Regents with Advanced Designation, which places the high school in the "select company" of the most prestigious high schools in New York State. Marcellus High School has had multiple National Merit Finalists in recent years.
- M The campus is fully wired with fiber optic cable and students have access to a wide variety of technology applications.
- M An extensive extra-curricular program provides students with the opportunity to grow and develop their talents.
- M Approximately 95% of all graduates go on to post-secondary education. Marcellus graduates can be found in some of the most prestigious colleges and universities in America. From the challenge and rigor of Advanced Placement/collegelevel courses to a specialized environmental curriculum to newly offered dual credit courses (college and high school credit), to career and technical training, the senior high school staff is dedicated to the success of each individual student and helps them achieve their full potential.

OUR COMMUNITY

The Marcellus Central School District is located in the village of Marcellus, N.Y., which has about 6,200 residents and lies 12 miles southwest of Syracuse, the fifth-largest city in the state and the heart of the Central New York region. In addition, the district serves the children of Marietta, which sits along the shores of Otisco Lake, as well as small portions of several other towns.

This scenic region provides a diverse blend of urban, suburban and rural areas and a wealth of educational, recreational and employment opportunities, Colleges in the immediate area include Syracuse University, Le Moyne College, the State University of New York (SUNY) College of Environmental Science and Forestry, SUNY Upstate Medical University, SUNY Oswego, SUNY Cortland and a variety of regional community colleges. A wealth of hospitals and medical providers serve the health needs of the region. Recreational opportunities abound, with the village lying within close proximity to popular destinations such as the New York Finger Lakes, the Adirondacks, and New York City.

OUR DISTRICT

The Marcellus Central School District is a small, tight-knit community dedicated to the success of its children. Since its inception in 1933, the district has established a rich tradition of high student achievement in the areas of academics, the arts, music, co-curricular programs and athletics. Today the district serves approximately 1,407 students with about 300 full-time and part-time faculty and staff members. The district consistently provides its staff with high-quality professional development so students can benefit from the most effective, innovative and research-driven strategies for improving academic achievement and enhancing their overall well-being.

The Marcellus school community is also proud of its buildings and grounds, including the recently renovated high school building and a refurbished track and new turf on the athletic stadium field. In the spring of 2023, the district will embark on a \$17 million project to replace major sections of the roofs on all three buildings as well as a large paving and traffic-flow project surrounding the high school building. It is our hope that during the fall and winter of the 2023-24 school year, new agriculture facilities will also be constructed across the parking lot from the high school. These new facilities will greatly enhance the safety and comfort of the district and provide incredible new instructional spaces for students and the community to enjoy for many years to come.


