


DISTRICT PROFILE

The Cazenovia Central School District is located in a suburban/rural community of approximately 10,000 people, primarily from the townships of Cazenovia, Nelson, Fenner, and the Village of Cazenovia in Madison County, N.Y. The district, which is located 20 miles southeast of Syracuse, blends historic villages and hamlets with extensive agricultural land. A residential community with agricultural roots, Cazenovia has a diverse socioeconomic spectrum. Residents demonstrate strong support for the school system and a high level of interest in the school's many academic, athletic, and extracurricular programs.



- The 2020-2021 budget of \$31,052,000 supports many outstanding programs. State Aid provides 31% of the budget, with approximately 64% coming from local taxes. The balance of the budget comes from district investments (about 3%) and fund balance and/or other sources (about 2%).
- Cazenovia Central School District has 246 employees and a management team that consists of a seven-member Board of Education, superintendent, an assistant superintendent, coordinator of athletics and communications, pupil personnel services, director of facilities, transportation supervisor, three principals and an assistant principal.

Burton Street Elementary School is a close-knit school community serving K-4 students. Students with disabilities are educated within the general education classroom and supported through co-teaching or consultation models. Intervention services are provided in several areas. The school offers one-to-one technology for all students, a strong character education program, and after-school programs.

The dedicated staff at Cazenovia Middle School partners with students, families and the community to inspire and promote personal success. Positive behavior and strong relationships are formed through Cazenovia Lakers Unite time, which promotes a school-wide community. Opportunities for students to study foreign languages in grade 5, as well as accelerated math in grade seven, enhance the instructional program. The school offers a diverse selection of extracurricular clubs and activities, including modified sports and performing arts.



Applications must be postmarked by March 26, 2021 and include a letter of application, a completed application form, a current resume, a copy of the School District Administrator certificate and an updated university placement folder. Candidates will be screened by Dr. Cook and recommended to the Board. The final choice of a superintendent will be the responsibility of the Board of Education. An appointment is expected to be made in May 2021 with the new superintendent expected to start the position by July 1, 2021.
